






Global Energy Mix







WPC Energy appoints first female Director General (CEO) in 91 years

(WO) — WPC Energy, the World Forum for Energy Transformation, has announced the appointment of Burcu Canci Gunal as Director General (CEO), effective january 1, 2025.

Prior to this appointment, Buncu worked for Turkish Petroleum for 28 years, latterly setting up and assuming the role of Managing Director of the Carbon Management Department, overseeing corporate roadmaps and energy transition initiatives covering energy efficiency, GHG emissions management, carbon markets and renewables. Previous roles which Burcu has held within Turkish Petroleum include Deputy Managing Director of the Strategy Department and Head of the Corporate Communications Division.





Untapped Reserves Survey

The only recurring Gender - DE&I Survey within the global energy sector

- Conducted with BCG since 2017
- Female representation in the global energy sector : 23% (the 2nd worst performing sector)
- The Survey report shares data, trends, best practices (enabling energy companies to understand areas of priority and achieve more informed decision-making)
- Version 4.0 to be released in 2026


LEWAS



WPC Energy Congress


- **Biennial** from 2026 (triennial before)




